

## College-in-the-High School

### Important Information

Students entering their Junior or Senior year in September 2017 may enroll in courses.

Students may enroll in course(s) offered in any high school regardless of their home school district.

### Course Design

Summer courses will be offered in either a Traditional (T) or Hybrid (H) format. Hybrid classes have fewer in classroom sessions with activities done online using the Columbia-Greene Community College Blackboard platform. This is accessible from any computer with an internet connection, no special software needed.

### Cost

The cost of a College-in-the-High School course is one-third (1/3) of the regular rate.

**3 credits = \$183**

**4 credits = \$244**

(Textbook costs are not included).

### Registration

#### Eligibility Requirements

1. Students must be enrolled in a Regents Program.
2. Students must have an average of 80 or above in the subject area.
3. If there is no course history in the subject area, an average of 80 or above is required in English or Math depending on the course.

#### Procedures

1. Obtain a College-in-the-High School Form from your High School Guidance Counselor.
2. Complete the form, including parent/guardian signature.
3. Return completed form to Guidance Office.
4. Guidance Office submits form with final transcript to Columbia-Greene Community College for approval.

*All qualifying students will receive additional information from the Columbia-Greene Community College Admissions Office regarding tuition and other requirements.*
