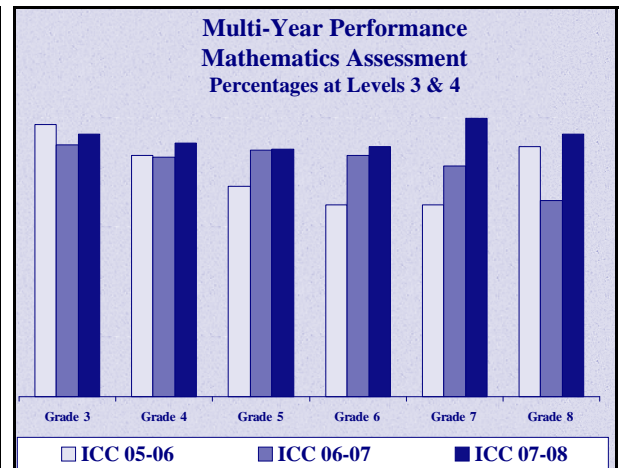
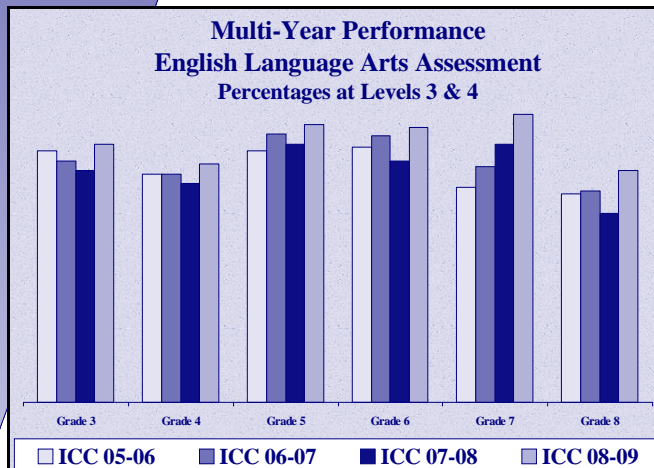

## ACADEMICS AT ICC

- Approximately 89% of the Class of 2008 pursued higher education
- 89% of 2008 graduates earned a Regents Diploma; 60% of 2008 graduates earned a Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation
- 10 teams competed in the 2009 regional Odyssey of the Mind competition; one elementary team advanced to the New York State finals and other teams finished in second and third place

Based on New York State testing in 2007-08, the District is meeting and/or exceeding state and regional averages in grades 3 through 8 for English language arts (ELA) and Math.



### Transportation

*FAST Facts*  
The District uses centralized routing to transport 2,206 public and private school students to 32 different school buildings, traveling 662,576 miles so far this year.

## ENERGY SAVINGS at ICC



### Reduced energy consumption = Reduced costs

For the third consecutive year, each school in the District has been named as an ENERGY STAR building. Additionally, the District has again achieved the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) distinguished Energy Star Leader Award. To date, the District has significantly reduced energy consumption;

### The ARTS at ICC

- The District participates in the Arts in Education program, which sponsors field trips and performances relating to the curriculum for students District-wide throughout the school year
- Art courses offered at the High School include painting, drawing, illustration, photography, computer graphics, sculpture, and ceramics
- Students' work can be viewed on the District's Web site, calendar, yearbook, school publications, Chatham Fair, Hudson Winter Walk, Legislative Art Show, and Columbia-Greene Community College

### MUSIC/ THEATRE at ICC

- 627 students in grades 5 – 12 participate in chorus and band
- 179 students participate in extracurricular music performing ensembles including Middle School Jazz Ensemble, High School Jazz Ensemble, Sing Swing, High School Spectrum, and Marching Band
- 169 District students have been accepted in All County Honor Music groups
- A cast of more than 72 students from the Crane Acting Troupe and 40 faculty and community volunteers have presented the Spring musical, *Grease*

### ATHLETICS at ICC

- Approximately 500 students participate in 47 teams at the varsity, junior varsity, and modified levels
- To date, 6 teams have won the Patroon Conference title; 2 teams have advanced to Section II final championships; 13 of 16 Fall and Winter teams have earned Scholar/Athlete Awards with a team average of 90 or greater

### ADVANCED PLACEMENT at ICC

- 402 enrollments in upper level courses that lead to advanced placement (AP) or college credit
- Students who are eligible can take the AP exam in English literature, US history, world (global) history, and calculus
- College-level courses are offered in psychology, calculus, statistics, algebra, pre-calculus, composition, advanced biology, and technical physics. French and Spanish are offered through SUNY Albany.
