The Ichabod Crane Summer School is an accredited program offering secondary level remedial instruction for all students in the district and surrounding areas. All staff are NYS certified teachers.

**Special Offerings:** Based upon need, it is possible that in addition to the remedial instruction offered, special regents review classes may be made available for those students who wish to only retake the regents. Classes will be 2 hrs long. These classes and their exact times will not be determined until after the June NYS Regents and based on need and interest and availability of instructors.

**Economics:** Again this year, there will be a 20 hour test-out course for students who plan to take Western Civilization, Latin/South America or Psychology next year. This course is offered to Ichabod Crane students only. It will run from July 7<sup>th</sup> to July 17<sup>th</sup> four days a week. The final exam will be on July 18<sup>th</sup>. If enrollment is high, a second session is possible and will run from July 21<sup>th</sup> to July 31<sup>st</sup> for four days a week. The final exam will be on August 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Driver's Education:** Two courses will be offered. Both courses will begin on July 1<sup>st</sup> and end August 12<sup>th</sup> 2008. Sessions will run from 7:00 AM to 1:00 PM five days a week on a rotating basis. All student drivers must have a valid NYS Learner's Permit or Driver's License. Registration will be according to age. Any remaining slots will be offered to out-of-district students. **Please note** that this summer, there will be a charge of \$250 for resident students and \$275 for non-resident students.

**Attendance:** There is a direct connection between success in summer school and attendance. Please be to every class on time. Chances for success increase with excellent attendance.

**Registration** will be held in the Ichabod Crane High School Library on July 2<sup>nd</sup> and July 3<sup>rd</sup> from 9 to 12 noon. All students must present a signed registration card from his/her school principal or guidance counselor. **COURSES MAY BE CANCELLED OR MOVED TO A DIFFERENT TIME SLOT DUE TO INSUFFICIENT ENROLLMENT.**
